

Main Points from the March P.C.C. Meeting

Audio /Visual Equipment: Creative Systems and B.H. Sound are to be asked to supply more explicit replies to the list of queries. Further visits to churches with similar systems to those which St. Andrew's is considering will be made in order to ensure everyone agrees with the final choice. Both companies will demonstrate their systems. A faculty should be relatively easy to obtain. The adequacy of power supply will be investigated.

Ely 900 - Mission Action: The next steps are under discussion.

Pastoral Visiting: Volunteers have agreed to lead of a group of pastoral visitors.

Fundraising: Planning for the music concert planning is well on course and the event will be promoted after Easter. Dates of all the activities will be displayed on the notice board as soon as all are confirmed.

The Partnership: The report is being completed and its conclusions will be reported when they are announced.
